THE CHATEAUX POOL RULES

- 1. Certified lifeguards will be on duty at all times that the pool is open. No person shall use the pool facility unless the pool is officially open, and lifeguards are on duty. Unauthorized persons found inside the pool area when the pool is closed may lose their privileges for the remainder of the pool season. Lifeguards have the full authority to use their discretion to enforce the rules to ensure a safe and healthy environment- Lifeguards have the authority to remove anyone form the pool for infractions of the pool rules or when, in the sole discretion of the lifeguard, safety is threatened. The pool may be closed at the discretion of the Lifeguard in case of thunder, lightning, rain, operational breakdown, or unsanitary conditions.
- 2. Residents must complete a pool application and return it to Management to use the pool.
- 3. All residents are required to sign in upon arrival to the pool. Guests must be signed in as well and must be always accompanied by a resident. There will be a limit of 4 guests per unit.
- 4. Children under twelve (12) years of age must be accompanied by an individual (16) sixteen years of age or older at all times for admission to the pool or pool area.
- 5. The lifeguards reserve the right to close the pool for brief periods at any time depending on the circumstances and/or their needs.
- 6. Children wearing regular diapers will not be allowed in the pool. Children wearing swim diapers will be allowed in the pool.
- 7. Smoking is not permitted inside the pool deck area.
- 8. Running, diving or rough housing is not permitted.
- 9. Pets are not permitted inside the pool deck area, except for working dogs.
- 10. Swimmers must wear proper bathing attire. (Example no cut-off shorts, pants, etc.) All Adult swim wear must be appropriate for a family setting.
- 11. You must shower/rinse before entering the pool.
- 12. Persons who have obvious infections (colds, lesions, open sores, etc.) will not be allowed in the pool.
- 13. Radios and televisions are permitted in the pool deck area but must be used with headphones.
- 14. Safety is of primary concern to the Association. All persons using the pool do so at their own risk and agree to abide by the rules for use of the facility. The Association assumes no responsibility for any accident or injury in connection with using the facility or for loss or damage to personal property.
- 15. No parties or group outings will be allowed at the pool. The pool is not available for rent.
- 16. No large body rafts, inter tubes, or other flotation devices larger than 70 inches.
